The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF Junior World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day).
The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF Junior World Cup will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations "Edition 2017 – Second Print 01/2018". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website www.issf-sports.org.

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Juries, RTS Jury, and Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF Junior World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Rifle / Pistol Equipment

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

Rifle Clothing

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to Equipment Control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Rifle Clothing Post-Competition Stiffness Testing

If one panel of a rifle jacket or trousers tests 2.9 or lower, the stiffness device must be recalibrated and the panel must be retested. If it fails again, but all other panels pass, the athlete will not be disqualified, but a written warning must be given to the athlete and the ISSF seal must be cut off. The athlete can continue using this clothing for that day in that event. If two or more panels fail, the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Air or CO₂ Cylinders

It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that any air or CO₂ cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control.

Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory, however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Cartridge Controls

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labeled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first. If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g or less, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50g, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

During Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes, and the boxes will be sealed. The boxes must be left under the supervision of Equipment Control Jury Member on the FOP. Once ammunition is placed in the box and sealed, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. No additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals (There will be no elimination for 6th place; the first elimination will be for 5th place).

Colored Wad

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

4. Participation

Individual / Team Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of six (6) athletes per Junior World Cup event, and a maximum of two (2) teams per team event.

Mixed Team Events

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per mixed team event, consisting of one (1) man and one (1) woman.

ISSF ID Number

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF Junior World Cup.

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

Juniors

Juniors are athletes who will be under the age of 21 on 31st December 2018.

Athletes, born between 1 January 2000 and 31 December 2003, can achieve Minimum Qualification Score (MQS) for the 2018 Youth Olympic Games Buenos Aires (ARG) in the 10m Air Rifle Men Junior/Women Junior and 10m Air Pistol Men Junior/Women Junior events.

Results obtained during this ISSF Junior World Cup will NOT be recognized as MQS for 2020 Olympic Games Tokyo (JPN).

Athlete biographies will be distributed and photos will be taken.

5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the established deadlines.

Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be submitted to ISSF Headquarters. Entry Forms are provided, but Member Federations are urged to use the ISSF Online Registration Service. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: “Summary of Deadlines”).

Preliminary Entries

ISSF Member Federations entering the ISSF Junior World Cup must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **26 JAN 2018**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

Final Entries

ISSF Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Final Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **17 FEB 2018**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

Late Entries

If the maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached, late entries will only be accepted until the Late Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **15 MAR 2018**.

Important Note: Until the 3 days Late Entry Deadline, the change of names / athletes within an event in the Final Entries is possible without restriction and additional fees.

Any additional entries received after the Late Entry Deadline, from **16 MAR 2018** onwards, may not participate.

Entry Confirmation upon arrival

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation Delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm their Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training.

Entry Changes after the Late Entry Deadline

From **16 MAR 2018** onwards, only the replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event is permitted and can be made only before 12:00h on the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.

Cancellation

Any ISSF Member Federation that reduces the number of athletes listed in their Final Entries after the Final Entry Deadline (**17 FEB 2018**) must pay applicable entry fees and hotel room cancellation costs according to the number of athletes and entries on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid, no member of that federation may participate.

Entry Fee

The entry fees include all charges for registration, range hire, competition costs, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

The Entry Fees DO NOT include the cost of the Pre-Event and Unofficial Trainings for Shotgun.

Accreditation Process

All persons involved in the ISSF Junior World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media Persons) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Shotgun

The shooting range has 3 combined ranges for Trap/Double Trap/Skeet and 6 additional separate ranges for Skeet unofficial practice.

The Skeet ranges operate with acoustic and manual release system.

The firing direction of the shooting range is South.

The targets used for the ISSF Junior World Cup are eco-friendly, standard orange for the Qualification and flash orange for the Finals.

Firearms

All competitors and team officials who may handle firearms **must** apply for a firearms license by completing the P634 Firearms Permit and Overseas Temporary Visitors Competitor Legitimate Reason form (OTVCLR). Junior competitors (minors) under the age of 18 years must also provide a complete Sections 6 and 7 of the OTVCLR and provide supporting documents.

All possible competitors that may be competing at this ISSF Junior World Cup for your country (even if you withdraw them at a later date) are required to complete both the P634 Firearms Permit and Overseas Temporary Visitors Competitor form and return them along with a scanned copy of the supporting documents listed below to the Organizing Committee by no later than **31 JAN 2018**.

Australian Firearms Laws require any person handling, carrying or using an Air Rifle or Pistol, .22 Rifle or Pistol or a Shotgun to have a Firearms Permit.

Competitors application

- Application on P634 form - with country of residence address details
- Overseas Visitors Competitors Legitimate Reason form (OVCLR) (For under 18 year olds needs sign off by parents/guardian)
- Passport details showing name, date of birth, home address, passport number, country of issue and date of expiry
- Australian visa and date of expiry
- Applicant's firearms license number, country of issue and date of expiry (if applicable), or
- If a firearms license is not applicable police certification has been supplied (i.e. Section 4 of legitimate reason form is completed) to certify that the applicant is lawfully entitled to possess, carry and use in that country the type of firearms for which the permit is sought
- The make, model, caliber, action and serial number of the firearm for which the permit is sought
- If more than one firearm is being imported, details of the special need for additional firearms must be supplied
- A copy of club membership (if applicable and translated into English)
- B709 Individual application - can't be submitted by the Junior must be submitted by the person bringing the firearms in (and is also authorized to possess with a permit)
- B709 Ammunition Application
- B709 ABC – for shotgun and rifle shooters - **ensure all fields are complete with the firearms details**
- B709 H - for pistol shooters - **ensure all fields are complete relating to the firearm details**

Additional requirement for competitor under the age of 18

- Details of person travelling with minor (i.e. parent, guardian, coach, relative) **completed on the legitimate reason form (OVCLR section 7)**
- Consent from the parent or legal guardian, including certification that the information provided on the application is correct (**OVCLR section 6**). In addition, the parent or guardian must supply proof of identity or documentation to prove legal guardian status.

Coaches/Assistant Coaches/Support staff applications

- Application on P634 form with country of residence address details
- Legitimate reason form (including details of firearms requiring possession)
- Passport details
- Visa

All supporting information documents are required to be legible and translated into English prior to submission.

Please Note: The NSW Government charges a fee for each Firearms Permit application. This applies for all applications, regardless if that athlete does or does not end up travelling. Please note these applications **must be lodged before 31 JAN 2018** or they will not be issued. The Fee for each Firearm Permit is 95 AUD (approx. 65 EUR per permit application). This will be added to the invoice sent to each Country at the same time as the entry fees and must be paid as per the entry fee process listed above.

It is highly unlikely that a firearm permit submitted after the 31 JAN 2018 will be accepted by the NSW Government. To submit a firearm, permit after the 31 JAN 2018 an additional \$50 AUD will be charged regardless of the outcome.

Airport Departures

Be aware that International Flights will require a minimum check-in time of 3 hours prior to departure with firearms. Allowing 1-hour drive from the range and an additional ½ hour from hotel to the range to collect the firearms you will require 4 ½ hours prior to a flight to collect firearms. It is strongly encouraged you do not book early morning departures.

The SISC will open at 07:00 a.m. on the official departure day for firearms collection. Therefore, it is best to book departure flights that are on or after 11:00 a.m. After the official departure day the SISC will open at 08:00 a.m.

Local Transportation – Shuttle Service

Local Transportation between the official hotels and the shooting range will be offered from 20 MAR 2018 (PET /Opening Ceremony/Technical Meeting) through to and including 28 MAR 2018 (final day of competition) as part of the entry fee.

10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range

Technical Meeting

The Technical Meeting will take place on **20 MAR 2018**, at the shooting range / Finals Hall. Each participating ISSF Member Federation is kindly requested to have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition and Training Schedules, draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF Junior World Cup. The time of the meeting will be confirmed after the Final Entry Deadline.

Storage of Firearms and Ammunition

For arrival please note: Upon your arrival in Sydney, AUS, all firearms and ammunition have to be transported to the Shooting Range **directly**.

For departure please note: All firearms and ammunition have to be removed from the armory for direct transit to the airport, on the day of departure, not before.

Sydney International Shooting Centre has the firearm storage located on level 2 of the venue. There are 3 armories plus housing for competitor's bags and non-firearm equipment.

The armory will be opened from the Official Arrival Day until the Official Departure Day, any teams arriving / departing outside of these dates please advise the Organizing Committee so alternate arrangements can be made with Sydney International Shooting Centre. See 9 above for departure times. Firearms stored before 19 MAR 2018 or after 30 MAR 2018 will incur a cost of \$3.80 AUD per firearm/day.

Firearms stored from 15 Mar 2018 to 20 MAR 2018 for competitors competing in the TRA (Target Rifle Australia) Nationals will not pay a fee.

Ammunition

The Ammunition Prices will be supplied prior to close of Final Entries. Athletes will be able to pay for any ammunition purchased direct to the Sydney International Shooting Centre via cash or credit card at the range.

NSW laws will only allow ammunition to be purchased by those that hold a Commissioners Permit/International Competitors/Coach visitors permit authorizing the possession of ammunition. **Ammunition will not be able to be purchased by those under 18 years of age.**

Doping Control Tests

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan under the supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

Pre-Event Training (PET)

The SISC will require to view your Australian Shooters International Shooting Permit (Commissioners Permit) upon arrival along with your passport each day of practice. Please ensure you have them with you at all times. You will also be required to have your permit with you every day of the competition. All fees will be paid direct to SISC prior to commencement of training. These fees can be paid by cash or credit card at the SISC reception.

WIFI

The SISC buildings are fitted with Wi-Fi transmitters. Wi-Fi will be free of charge.

11. Ceremonies

Opening and Closing Ceremony

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 20 MAR 2018, directly prior to the Technical Meeting, at Sydney International Shooting Centre. Exact time will be confirmed with the distribution of the Final Competition Schedule.

There will be no Closing Ceremony.

Victory Ceremony

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the shooting range immediately after the end of each Finals (see also: Final Competition Schedule for exact details).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

Flags and Anthems

All participating teams are required to bring with them three (3) national flags (1x2m) and one (1) copy of their national anthem (CD), and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the registration process.
