

International Competition Air Rifle and Air Pistol 2nd – 5th of January 2008 in Sweden.

Swedish Shooting Sports Federation invites all Shooters and Coaches to Sävsjö and the Swedish cup 2008.

Place:

Sävsjö shooting center, Sävsjö, in the south of Sweden.

Programme:

- 2 Jan Arrival day, training and equipment control 16.00-20.00 Technical Meeting 20.00
- 3 Jan First competition day
- 4 Jan Second competition day and day for team competition
- 5 Jan Third competition day

Finals starts after last pistol relay and continue thereafter for all events (pistol and rifle) every day.

Disciplines:

60 / 40 shots Air Rifle, 60 / 40 shots Air Pistol.

Team Competition:

Will be carry out on the second competition day, 2008-01-04 Team competition for pre selected nation team (max 2 teams per nation and event) Team competition for pre selected club team (max 1 team per club and event) Team members must participate in the same class.

(Eg: all members in a women team must participate in women events) Last date for entry in the team competition is 2008-01-03 at 12.00

Category:

Male, male junior, female, female junior. Swedish cup is open for disabled competitors in class SH 1.

Entry forms:

You find the entry form on Swedish cup official homepage. You can also use our Web-based entry form. Please return the entry form no later than 1st December 2008.

To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to register individual entry form, but all shooters from one club together in one entry form.

Entry fees:

600 SEK per shooter for all 3 competition days. 200 SEK in team competition. Entry fee must be paid at the same time as entry form is completed for the competition. Information about payment methods is described under "How to Pay" on Swedish cup official homepage 2008. To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to pay individual fees, but all shooters from one club together in one entry fee.

Awards:

Medals for the 3 best and 3 best team in each event. 2.000 SEK to the best shooter in all disciplines

Accommodation:

Airport:

Nearest Airports are Växjö 80 km and Jönköping 70 km. Good alternative: Kastrup Airport/DEN and train to Sävsjö.

Transportation:

Airport - Hotel, return tickets 100 SEK/person Hotel - Shooting Range 300 SEK during all competition days. All transportations are booked through the transportation order form.
