Place:

Sävsjö shooting center, Sävsjö, in the south of Sweden.

Program:

3 January Arrival day. Equipment Control open 1200-1900. Training: Pistol 1300-1700. Rifle 1500-1900. Running target 1800-2000

- 4 January First competition day
- 5 January Second competition day and day for team competition
- 6 January Third competition day

The finals starts, for rifle and pistol, each day after the last pistol relay. Medal match (RT 30/30 and Mixed 20/20 counts together) after last relay.

Disciplines:

60/40 shots Air Rifle, 60/40 shots Air Pistol, Running target 30+30 and Mixed 20+20.

Category:

Male, male junior, female, female junior. Minimum 3 shooter/category. Swedish cup is open for disabled competitors in class SH 1.

Team Competition:

Will be carried out on the second day of competition. 3 shooters in each team. Team competition for pre selected nation team (max 2 teams per nation and event) Team competition for pre selected club team (max 1 team per club and event) Not RT. Team members must participate in the same class.

(Eg: all members in a women team must participate in women events) Last date for entry in the team competition is 2009-01-04 at 12.00

Entry forms:

You find the entry form on the official website of the Swedish Cup. You can also use our Web-based entry form.

Please return the entry form no later than December 1st 2008.

To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to register individual entry forms, but, instead, to use one entry form per club.

Entry fees:

600 SEK per shooter for all 3 competition days. 200 SEK in team competition. Entry fees must be paid at the same time as entry form is completed for the competition.

Information about payment methods is described under "How to Pay" on the Swedish cup official website . To minimize our workload we ask all Swedish shooters not to pay their fees individually, but, instead, that all the entry fees from one club are paid at the same time.

Awards:

Medals for the 3 best shooters in each event. In team competition medals for the 3 best team in each event. 2000 SEK to the best shooter in all disciplines.

Accommodation:

Airport:

Nearest Airports are Växjö 80 km and Jönköping 70 km. Good alternative: Kastrup Airport/DEN and train to Sävsjö.

Transportation:

Airport - Hotel, return tickets 100 SEK/person Hotel - Shooting Range 300 SEK during all competition days. All transportations are booked through the transportation order form.
