The Preliminary Competition Schedule of the ISSF World Cup is attached to this General Information. The Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule) will be distributed after the Official Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day). The latest Schedule updates will be provided at the Technical Meeting.

### 3. Rules and Regulations

The ISSF World Cup will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules and Regulations "Edition 2013 (Third Print, 01/2015) – Effective 1 January 2013". Detailed information is available on the ISSF website [www.issf-sports.org](http://www.issf-sports.org).

ISSF Juries (Jury of Appeal, Competition Jury, Classification Jury, Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the ISSF to supervise the ISSF World Cup. Qualified Range Officers / Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Under rules adopted in 2013, pre-competition testing is no longer mandatory. However as

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before, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing and are urged to submit all doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competitions. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing according to ISSF Rule 6.7.9 and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

All rifle athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their jackets and trousers. Any rifle jackets or trousers that do not have ISSF seals must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the athlete's first competition. Jackets and trousers that were previously inspected and have an ISSF seal continue to be valid except that athletes with more than one jacket or trousers must report to Equipment Control before their first competition to confirm which jacket and which trousers they will use. All other seal numbers for that athlete will be cancelled. Athletes that wish to replace a registered jacket or trousers with a new clothing item must bring that item to equipment control for inspection and a new seal. Previous seals will then be cancelled. Rifle athletes can have only one active jacket and trousers at any time.

Regarding the use of air or CO<sup>2</sup> cylinders, please refer to ISSF Rule 6.2.4.2. that states: "It is the athlete's responsibility that any air or CO<sup>2</sup> cylinder is still within its validity date. This may be checked by Equipment Control."

#### **4. Participation**

ISSF Member Federations may enter a maximum of three (3) athletes per World Cup event and up to two (2) additional athletes to shoot for "MQS only". The additional "MQS only" athletes will be listed separately according to their results, but without ranking – these results cannot be recognized as World Records (**ISSF Rule 3.9.5**).

The maximum number of starts per event is the number of athlete entries that can be handled and accepted for each ISSF World Cup event. Range capacity is determined by the available shooting time and the number of available firing points.

If the maximum number of starts is reached during the Final Entry process, a "waiting list" for that event(s) will be established. If cancellations are subsequently received, entries from the waiting list will be entered on a first come, first served basis. ISSF Headquarters and the Organizing Committee will cooperate to determine if additional entries from the waiting list can be accommodated.

#### **ISSF ID Number**

All athletes must sign an "Athlete's Declaration" and have an official ISSF ID number issued before participation in the ISSF World Cup (**ISSF Rule 3.6.6**).

Athletes without ISSF ID number will not be allowed to participate. ISSF ID numbers can be obtained from the ISSF Headquarters by using the official application form.

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Quota Places for the 2016 Olympic Games Rio de Janeiro (BRA) will be awarded according to the Qualification System.

Detailed information is available on the ISSF website [www.issf-sports.org](http://www.issf-sports.org).

Results of the ISSF World Cup will be recognized as MQS for the 2016 OG.

Athlete biographies will be distributed and photos will be taken at the shooting range.

## 5. Entry Process

Please complete the attached Registration Forms (Annex 1 – 9) and return them by the set deadlines. Preliminary and Final Entries for Athletes and Officials must be returned to the ISSF Headquarters. All other Registration Forms must be returned to the Organizing Committee (see also: Summary of Deadlines).

### **Preliminary Entries (ISSF Rule 3.7.3.1)**

ISSF Member Federations entering the ISSF World Cup must submit the Preliminary Entries not later than **8 JAN 2015**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Preliminary Entry Form (Annex 1) and return it by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

### **Final Entries (ISSF Rule 3.7.3.2)**

ISSF Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the ISSF HQ. The Official Entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival day) is **9 MAR 2015**.

Please use the ISSF Online Registration Service <http://entry.issf-sports.info>, or exceptionally complete the Final Entry Forms (Annex 3) and return them by email or fax to the ISSF Headquarters.

### **Late Entries (ISSF Rule 3.7.3.4)**

Late Entries will only be accepted until the Final Entry Deadline (3 days before the Official Arrival day) which is **4 APR 2015**, if maximum number of athlete entries have not been reached.

Any additional entries received after the Final Entry Deadline, from **5 APR 2015** onwards, may not participate (**ISSF Rule 3.7.3.5**)

### **Entry Changes after the Final Entry Deadline**

From **5 APR 2015** onwards, only the following changes in the Final Entries are permitted:

- a) Replacement of a registered athlete by another already registered athlete in another event (**ISSF Rule 3.7.3.6**) can be made only before 12:00h the day before the Pre-Event Training for that event.
- b) Change of Status in an event (**ISSF Rule 3.7.3.7**): a “MQS only” athlete can replace a withdrawn “World Cup / Quota” athlete. The withdrawn “World Cup / Quota” athlete may not shoot for “MQS only”. The exchange of athletes within an event is not permitted.

### **Entry Confirmation upon arrival**

All Team Leaders of ISSF Member Federation delegations must report to the OC Entries Official and confirm the Final Entries. The confirmation must be completed before 12:00h the day before the Pre-Event Training.

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**Cancellation (ISSF Rule 3.7.4.3)**

Any ISSF Member Federation reducing the number of athletes and / or officials after the Official Entry Deadline (**9 MAR 2015**) is obligated to pay all applicable fees and costs including entry fees according to the number of starts on the Final Entry Forms originally received. If the applicable fees and costs are not paid no member of that federation may participate.

**Entry Fee (ISSF Rule 3.7.3.4.3 and 3.7.4)**

The entry fees include all charges for registration, local transportation between shooting range and official hotels and doping control.

**Payment of Entry Fees**

Accreditation for final registration as well as payment for entry fees and local accommodation should be made by one (1) person representing national federation at a time from 08:30-14:00 on 9 APR 2015 to the OC office located at the shooting range. All payment has to be effected cash only in Euro. Traveler's checks or credit cards will not be accepted.

However, the participating federation, if available, is kindly requested to wire 100% of entry fees and local accommodation to the OC in advance to expedite the accreditation on 9 APR 2015. The deposit is to be transferred indicating country or federation and copies of the transfer voucher should reach the OC at the latest **20 MAR 2015** in order OC to notify those federations of net amount before leaving their country. Please make sure that any deposit balance caused by T/T charge of the wiring and intermediate bank must be shouldered by the federation.

All extra charges such as telecommunication, mini bar, extra meals and laundry etc occurred at the official hotels have to be paid to the hotel directly at the check-out.

**Accreditation Process**

All persons involved in the ISSF World Cup (Athletes, Team Officials, ISSF Officials, OC Officials, Media) must have accreditations that clearly identify the accreditation holder (with photograph, family name and first name, nation and function) in order to use the local transportation and to enter controlled areas on the shooting range.

Accreditations (for persons registered before the Final Entry Deadline and with photograph in the ISSF database) will be prepared by the ISSF Headquarters and OC. All other accreditations will be prepared by the Accreditation Office of the ISSF World Cup.

Accreditations will be distributed by the Organizing Committee after payment of the entry fees.

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## 6. Shooting Range

The ISSF World Cup will take place at the Shooting Range in Changwon, Republic of Korea.

The shooting range is equipped as follows:

The firing direction of the 50m and 25m range is north.

## 7. Immigration and Customs Requirements

### Entry Visas

The participating federations, which require entry visa into Korea, are kindly requested to obtain it before departure from their country. If needed, please fill in the enclosed Visa Support Form (Annex 7) and send it to the OC in time but not later than **2 MAR 2015**. Upon request, the OC will send Official Invitation Letter to apply for their entry visa at the Korean Embassy or Consulate in their respective countries, or where required in case of countries having no diplomatic relations with a Republic of Korea.

**The Korea Shooting Federation has no influence on the embassy and, due to the past problems, can provide the invitation regarding the ISSF World Cup only!**

### Gun License

All participating federations must declare all of firearms and ammunitions brought in Korea for the ISSF World Cup in advance. They are kindly requested to complete the Firearm and Ammunition Form (Annex 8) and return it together with passport copies of each athlete to the OC as early as possible, but not later than **2 MAR 2015**.

The charge for an approved firearms and ammunitions declaration is **EUR 30.00 per federation**. This fee has to be wired or paid to the OC Headquarters by 14:00h on 9 APR 2015.

### Custom Clearance

All delegates are requested to arrange the **Busan Airport (PUS)** for arrival and departure. International airlines mainly running from Asian countries can be reached to the Busan Airport directly, whereas most of connections from the American and European continents, except for Munich (GER), should be through the **Seoul-Incheon International Airport (ICN)**. The delegates, which are through the Incheon airport, may transfer to a flight for Busan (PUS) at the ICN, or move to the **Seoul Airport (GMP)** by bus to connect the domestic flight for Busan.

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Our government requests that the custom formalities for all luggage and firearms must be made at the first international airport of Korean National Territory upon arrival and at the last one upon departure. A team leader or managers requested to submit the clear copies of passport of all participating athletes to the OC at the shooting range at final registration and payment on **9 APR 2015**.

The importation of necessary firearms shall be accepted,, if Firearms and Ammunition Form is sent to the OC within the deadline (**2 MAR 2015**). The following air routes will be available for arrival at the ISSF World Cup:

- a) Busan (PUS<sup>\*\*\*</sup>)  
From Germany (Munich), Japan (Tokyo, Fukuoka, Nagoya, Osaka), China (Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Qingdao), Thailand (Bangkok), Singapore, Philippines (Manila, Cebu), Hong Kong China, Chinese Taipei, Vietnam (Hochiminh, Hanoi), Laos (Vientian), Guam etc
- b) Incheon (ICN<sup>\*\*\*</sup>) → Busan (PUS) flight 3 times (08:55, 17:55, 20:40) daily
- c) Incheon (ICN<sup>\*\*\*</sup>) → Seoul (GMP) → Busan (PUS)

✈ Incheon → Seoul (land): Please consider at least **4 (four) hours** for the safe flight connection between two airports (Incheon-Seoul).

✈ Seoul → Busan (flight): every 30 minutes (07:00 to 20:30) daily

Note! (\*\*\*) is the international airport requiring the firearms' custom formalities.

Flight time described in b) & c) is subject to change.

**In case of b) and c), please make sure that all firearms and ammunitions including air guns and air pellets should be handed over to the OC staffs at the Seoul-Incheon Airport (ICN) just after police check and custom formalities. Those firearms will be transported to the shooting range armory in Changwon directly by the OC staffs. The same procedure will be also made at departure.**

## 8. Accommodation

### Official Hotels

5 (five) official hotels located at downtown in Changwon are arranged for all ISSF participating federations. The price includes breakfast, tax and service charges.

**No payment to the ISSF or the hotel – Payment must be made directly to the Organizing Committee!**

All room rates are calculated per room / per night.

### HISNT Canberra Hotel (\*\*\*)

Single EUR 85.00 Twin EUR 118.00

As a tourist class hotel, accommodation is available at the 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> floors in combination with many facilities for shopping, dining and relaxing. 220/240 V AC. The hotel possesses modern 90 rooms. All well equipped with automatic cooling/heating control device, mini bar, TV, refrigerator, radio, automatic international call, hair dryer, bathroom articles (toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, body cleanser and comb), bathtub, shoes cleaner, shoes brush, etc. Check-out time is 12:00h. Hot breakfast buffet is included.

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**Dragon Hotel (\*\*\*)** Rooms available are limited because of conference.

The hotel offers 70 rooms with air conditioning, heating system (central concentration system & individual controller), mini bar, soften water by special machine in bathroom, TV, hair dryer, refrigerator, bathroom articles (toothpaste, soap, shampoo, comb and body cleanser), bathtub, etc. 220/240V AC. The hotel is located behind the Changwon Bus Terminal. 24 hours high speed internet connection in room / lobby, and sauna is free of charge. Check-out time is 12:00h. It takes about 40 minutes from Busan Airport by taxi. Buffet breakfast is included.

**International Hotel (\*\*\*\*)**

Single EUR 108.00 Twin EUR 148.00

The hotel offers 120 rooms with multi-channel CATV, refrigerator, percolator, individual thermostat control, lab top (possible to rent), air conditioner, bathtub, bidet, dresser, hair dryer, high speed internet (Free wired & wireless connection), etc. 220/240 V AC. A variety of restaurants, a sauna and other amenities such as buffet restaurant, sauna, Korean restaurant, wedding hall, shopping arcade, bakery, business center, conference room, beauty salon and parking lot which can hold 400 cars. Buffet breakfast is included.

**Changwon Hotel (\*\*\*\*)**

The preferred hotel offers 173 rooms. 220/240 V AC. Multi-channel cable TV, movie channel, shower booth, complimentary internet, paperless toilet, domestic and inter-national newspapers, free laptop rental, complimentary use of business center fitness room, sauna and dry cleaning service are available. Limousine bus from the Busan Airport to Changwon every 3 hours. Buffet breakfast is included.

**The City 7 Pullman Hotel (\*\*\*\*\*)**

The first class hotel owns the variety of 321 rooms including 237 non-smoking ones. The hotel perfectly positioned in the central business district of Changwon City and neighbors a mega mall with the Changwon Exhibition Convention Center (CECO). 220/240 V AC, large LCD TV, air conditioning, mini bar, complimentary Wi-Fi & laptop high speed transmission line, thermal baths, bathtub in each room and business center, indoor & outdoor swimming pool and other sports activities & leisure, various shops and salons etc. Buffet breakfast is included.

Preliminary Hotel Reservation has to be effected by **8 JAN 2015**.

Final Hotel Reservation has to be effected by **2 MAR 2015**.

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Hotel reservation will be made through the Organizing Committee on a first come-first served basis, and the reservation can be only considered, once Final Hotel Reservation Form (Annex 5) and a **deposit of 80% have been received by the OC by 2 MAR 2015**. Then the Organizing Committee will confirm the hotel and its address. The Organizing Committee may not guarantee the accommodation in official hotels if the deposit is not made at the mentioned deadlines

Please make sure that **the official hotels may be booked through the Organizing Committee only**, and they will not take direct booking by federation/individual.

**The deadline for any change and cancel of hotel reservation is 15 MAR 2015.** In case of cancellation or non-show after this date, the penalty fee will be equal to **80%** of the total cost for any reserved and then cancelled or not occupied room since the WC dates are very high season in Changwon. The penalty fee will have to be paid through the OC, not the hotel.

#### **Food Service at the range**

Regional cuisine and beverages will be available at the restaurant at the range at the reasonable cost.

## **9. Travel and Transportation**

#### **Travel – Arrival**

The official airport for arrival and departure is the **Busan Airport (PUS)**.

#### **Airport pick up – Transportation to the Official Hotels (and return for departure)**

The delegates registered within the mentioned deadline will be met with the OC staffs in front of entrance exit at the Busan Airport (PUS). The official pick-up service will start at the official arrival day (**8 APR 2015**). Delegates arriving earlier than official arrival day or leaving after the official departure day (**16 APR 2015**) have to make their own arrangements. If requested in advance but not later than 8 MAR 2015, the OC will arrange airport pick-up service at the reasonable cost. It will be subject to the number of person and type of vehicle. It takes about 50 min. from the Busan Airport to the official hotels and the distance is approximately 40km. The delegates will be gone to the hotel directly, not through the shooting range. The same procedure will be made at departure as well.

#### **Local Transportation – Shuttle Service**

For the delegates who accommodate through the OC at the official hotels, shuttle service will be made between the hotels and the shooting range from **9 to 15 APR 2015**. The shuttle schedule will be available at the information desk at the hotels. It normally takes about 15 to 20 minutes from official

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hotels to the shooting range.

Please make sure that, in case accommodating at non-official hotels, those participants must cover all local transportation (airport-hotel-shooting range) by themselves.

## **10. Competition Related Procedures at the Shooting Range**

### **Technical Meeting**

The Technical Meeting will take place on 9 APR 2015 at 13:00h at the Finals Hall of the shooting range.

Each participating ISSF Member Federation should have at least one representative present at the Technical Meeting to receive updated information regarding Final Competition Schedule (including Training Schedule), draw procedures and other important issues related to the ISSF World Cup.

### **Storage of Firearms and Ammunition**

Storage of firearms and ammunitions will be available at the shooting range armory in front of main building. The armory will open from 07:30h to 18:00h during the official ISSF World Cup dates. Taking any firearms and ammunitions, including air guns and air pellets, out of the shooting range are absolutely prohibited in Korea. Otherwise it will be regarded the serious crime according to local safety regulations. Each day the armory staffs and police will check if all firearms return to the armory after training/competition.

### **Ammunition**

There is no limitation on the quantity of ammunition which the participants will bring into the Republic of Korea for the purpose of training and competition at the ISSF World Cup, if the amount is declared to the OC in advance but within the deadline (**2 MAR 2015**). However, please make sure that **the sale of ammunitions, including air pellets is NOT available in Korea**. The delegates are requested to bring all ammunitions with themselves which they will use for training and competition at the ISSF World Cup.

### **Doping Control Tests**

The Organizing Committee will conduct Doping Controls Tests according to the ISSF Anti-Doping Rules and the ISSF Test Distribution Plan under supervision of the ISSF Technical Delegate.

## **11. Ceremonies**

### **Opening and Closing Ceremony**

The Opening Ceremony will take place on 9 APR 2015 at 17:00h at the CECO in downtown. There will be no Closing Ceremony.

### **Victory Ceremony**

The Victory Ceremonies will take place at the Finals Hall immediately after the end of each Finals (see also: Final Competition Schedule).

During the ceremonies the athletes are required to present themselves in their official national uniform or national tracksuits (tops and bottoms).

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## **Flags and Anthems**

Each participating federation is kindly requested to bring two (2) national flags with 0.9 x1.35 m. National anthem will be arranged by the OC. If needed, the OC will contact the federation concerned in advance.

## **12. Weather Information**

During April, the weather in Changwon is normally pleasant with a little of rain. Average temperature will range 9°C - 10°C at night and 15°C - 20°C in the day. Average humidity ranges 60%.

## **13. Media Relations**

All Media representatives must register for the ISSF World Cup by using the Media Accreditation Form (Annex 9).

Media services will be available during the ISSF World Cup, equipped with telephone lines, facsimiles, e-mail service, pigeon holes for information, etc.

Upon arrival, athletes will be requested to fill in their Athlete Biography and return it to the Organizing Committee. It will be available for participants to take photos on training days.

Press conference, if requested, will take place at the range on 9 APR 2015.

## **14. Industry Service**

Firearm and equipment repair services, industry services and industry displays or exhibitions will be available at the shooting range. The industry is kindly requested to register to the OC by the same registration forms as the ISSF Member Federation do by the mentioned deadline in due time.
