3. RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Elva Open Air qualifications and finals will be conducted according to the ISSF Rules, only the composition of the finalists and mix teams is different.

To the super finals, held on Saturday evening, will advance the top 8 shooters from the absolute standings, where goes the better result of two starts.

Mix teams are assembled among the competitors, who confirm their participation no later than Saturday at 21.00, by the absolute standing. The pairs are formed as follows: from the absolute standing the first and the last, the second and the penultimate and so on.

Jury members are Marko Leppä FIN, Kaupo Kiis EST, Kristina Kivari EST, judges with valid ISSF A licenses.

4. RIFLE / PISTOL EQUIPMENT:

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments.

Pre-competition equipment control is not mandatory but however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random post-competition testing and will be disqualified if their equipment or clothing is not legal according to ISSF Rules.

6. SHOOTING RANGES AND VENUES:

Competition will be held in two separate places – in Elva Sport Hall and Tartumaa Tervisespordikeskus. The venues are situated 20 minute driving distance from the Tartucity centre, and 210 km from the Tallinn Airport or 225 km from Riga Airport.

1. In Elva Sport Hall we will hold air rifle and air pistol disciplines in 10m range, using SIUS electronic targets on 50 firing points.

Opening Ceremony and banquet are held on Friday 28.01. at 20:00. The participation of the banquet should be indicated on the registration form. The participation fee is 15.- €/per person.

The first award ceremony will take place at Sport Hall on Saturday evening after super finals.

The top three in all weapon types and age groups in the ranking, based on the best result from two starts, will be awarded with trophies and diplomas. 8 participants of the air rifle and air pistol super finals and 4 finalists of the running target will be awarded with sponsors' prizes.

The second award ceremony and Closing Ceremony will take place on Sunday after the finals of mix teams. The best 4 air rifles and 4 air pistol teams that took part in the finals will be awarded with sponsors' prizes.

In addition, many special and surprise prizes are planned.
